Mr. Roberts – West Leyden Elementary Principal/Director of Technology gave an overview of what Adirondack is doing for a Smart Schools Investment Plan.

In January of 2014 Governor Cuomo proposed NY State to invest \$2 billion to improve opportunities and learning with technology in schools through a Smart Schools Bond Act. The Adirondack Central School District was allocated \$1,397,402 and can use the money for six project categories, School Connectivity, Classroom Connectivity, High Tech Security Features, Community Connectivity, Pre-Kindergarten Programs and Classroom Trailers.

With expansion of infrastructure, Adirondack will be able to better meet instructional needs in the classroom and give students an enhanced 21st century learning experience. The final plan will be submitted to the State Educational Department for approval then it should take 5-6 weeks to get the district buildings up to par.

Mr. Gallo moved and Mrs. Beasock seconded, carried 7-0; the Board approved the presented Smart Schools Investment Plan.
