Jeff-Lewis BOCES Budget for 2019-20:

Mrs. Beasock moved and Mr. Gallo seconded, carried 7-0; the Board adopted the following resolution:

RESOLVED that the Adirondack Central School Board of Education hereby approves the 2019-2020 Administrative portion of the Jefferson-Lewis-Hamilton-Herkimer-Oneida Board of Cooperative Educational Services budget in the amount of \$4,201,335.
