TUESDAY, JUNE 16, 2020 via Livestream**

At the Annual District Meeting of the qualified voters of the Adirondack Central School District, Oneida County, New York, held in the Boonville Elementary by absentee ballot only per the Governor's Executive Order via livestream, in Boonville, New York, in said School District, on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2020, at 5:00 p.m., prevailing time.

Prior to the opening of absentee ballots, envelopes were canvassed for the signature of oath qualifying each voter.

At 5:02 p.m., prevailing time, the Permanent Chairperson, Edward Niznik, announced any voter challenges would be addressed for the first 15 minutes. Being no voter challenges after 15 minutes, the counting of absentee ballots proceeded. Attached hereto is a sample paper ballot.

At 9:02 p.m., prevailing time, the Permanent Chairperson, Edward Niznik, announced that all absentee ballots had been counted.

**BUDGET:**

**RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education of the Adirondack Central School District in Boonville, is hereby authorized to levy the necessary tax for and appropriate a sum not to exceed \$30,052,380 for the purpose of the General Fund Budget for the 2020-2021 school year.

**PROPOSITON – Capital Reserve Fund:**

**RESOLVED**, the Board of Education of the Adirondack Central School District is hereby authorized to establish a capital reserve fund pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law to be designated, “2020 Capital Reserve Fund” created to defray the cost of the construction and reconstruction of School District buildings and facilities, including original equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, furnishings and other incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, and to defray the cost of, in whole or in part, and in order to accomplish the same, the Board is hereby authorized to establish the ultimate amount of such reserve fund to \$10 million inclusive of accrued interest and other investment earnings, with a probable term of ten (10) years. The Board of Education is hereby authorized to pay funds from the available fund balance, state aid reimbursement to the School District on account of capital projects, such other monies as the voters may direct, and/or other legally available funds of the School District to such reserve fund in an amount determined by the Board of Education up to the maximum authorized amount.
